## Hours & Access – Peak Season

Memorial Day – Labor Day


Open: 7:00 AM – Dusk (≈ 30 min after sunset)

Entry by Resident Permit Sticker or









Pre-Purchased Non-Resident Day Pass Only

Gates Locked: Dusk to 7:00 AM

Vehicles left inside will be towed at owner's expense

 Anyone in the park during closed hours may be charged with trespassing and fined.

## Park Rules

1.  No swimming when lifeguard is not on duty
2.  No boats within 100 feet of the swim area
3.  No dogs on or near the beach (Leashed dogs allowed on trails only)
4.  No alcoholic beverages
5.  No loud or abusive language
6. No flotation devices allowed
7.  No bicycles, motorized vehicles, or ATVs on the beach
8.  Please clean up after yourself – use trash receptacles
9.  No open fires permitted
10. Pavilion available by reservation (for a fee) for Oxford residents.
